Tewatohnhi'saktha launches new website

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Kahnawà:ke (July 3, 2013) Tewatohnhi'saktha's new website, www.tewa.ca, went live earlier today, and has improved how visitors can get their information. Browsers will now be able to access programs, services, and information with one click of the mouse.

The re-vamp includes:

- Improved navigation: making it easier than ever to find what you're looking for.
- Improved user experience: faster navigation, easier accessibility, mobile accessibility and sharp new graphics
- Visual experience: a user-friendly interface for a user-friendly experience.
- New features: print-friendly versions of the web pages, easier access to news and events, more information readily available from the homepage, and more.
- Improved Job Posting Page: a free service to employers, this "job classifieds" section of the website is now kept current automatically.

Tewatohnhi'saktha has been planning a website update for quite some time in order to keep up with rapidly evolving technologies. Onokowa Technologies was chosen as the most qualified candidate after a Request for Proposals was released in December 2012, which generated zero responses from the community.
