Tewatohnhi'saktha Announces Scholarship Fund Recipient

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Kahnawà:ke (June 23, 2014) The Board of Directors announce that Bronson Cross has been chosen to be the recipient of the 2014 Tewatohnhi'saktha Scholarship Fund in the amount of \$3,000. Bronson Cross graduated from the John Molson School of Business and he is also a graduate of Concordia University with a Bachelor of Commerce majoring in International Business. Additionally Bronson graduated top 10% of this year's BComm Graduates, consisting of approximately 1300 students.

The Scholarship Fund was established to generate interest in a field of study where currently, only 1% of Kahnawake students are enrolled. The award is given to undergraduate students completing their degrees in Commerce, Information Technologies, and related fields.

"Mr. Cross was found to be an excellent candidate once again for the scholarship program. He was awarded the first half of the Scholarship in April, 2013 when he was entering his third semester. Now that he has graduated from Concordia University and continued to exceed eligibility requirements he is entitled to the second half of his Scholarship amount" said Tewatohnhi'saktha Board of Directors Chairperson Lionel Jacobs. Applications from students enrolled in the fall semester are due August 31, 2014.

Tewatohnhi'saktha will be presenting a cheque to Mr. Cross at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, June 23, 2014 in their Large Conference Room.
