### **WELCOME CENTER VISITORS**

We welcomed eight tour groups with four groups from Education First Tours (EF). The groups were visiting from the United States and Canada. Students took a Tour of Kahnawà:ke or chose a Lacrosse workshop at the Kahnawà:ke Youth Center. The groups then dined at the Kahnawà:ke Brewing Co. for dinner before heading to their next destination.

Tourism also welcomed two other student groups from Crofton House and Hampshire College, where they took a tour of Kahnawà:ke, Kateri Interpretive Center and the Language and Cultural Center. One corporate group took a tour of Kahnawà:ke and the Language and Cultural Center.

Tourism hosted a Familiarization Tour with our partners from Indigenous Tourism Quebec. They took a tour of the Language & Cultural Center, Kahnawà:ke, visited the Purple Dragonfly Trading Post and dined at the Two O Seven Steak and Seafood.

In March, a total of 18 visitors, stopped by the Welcome Center for information. They were visiting from Canada, the United States, Israel, and France.


The Crystal Connection is open Thursday to Saturday from 10:00am to 5:00pm.
